This project transforms a private villa into a warm Mediterranean retreat, defined by natural stone and soft earthy tones. The swimming pool, finished in Balli stone, creates a refined and natural water effect that anchors the outdoor space.

Mediterranean planting — including olive trees, cypress, and aromatic shrubs — ensures climate resilience and timeless character.

Marathonas Resort

Marathonas Resort is a luxurious hillside retreat overlooking the Argosaronic Gulf, designed for international high-end tourism. The project embraces modern architecture with simple geometry, clean lines, and a minimal yet refined character.

An infinity pool extends toward the horizon, seamlessly blending with the sea and becoming the resort's defining feature. Warm natural materials and understated finishes enhance the connection to the Greek landscape, creating an atmosphere of calm sophistication and elevated Mediterranean living.

Frequency

Frequency is a wooden sculpture that transforms the natural rhythms of its site—measured in Hz—into a physical form. Its flowing geometry expresses movement and wavelength, capturing the invisible pulse of the landscape.

Crafted from regenerative wood, the piece reflects cycles of renewal, where material and meaning are intertwined. Through light, shadow, and form, Frequency reveals the unseen energy of nature and its continuous state of regeneration.

Still Water

Located at the heart of the residence, Still Water Court is a minimalist water garden designed as a sanctuary of calm and contemplation.

A sculptural tree rests on a floating stone island, surrounded by a still reflecting pool that mirrors the sky and architecture. A simple floating walkway leads visitors through the space, creating a quiet journey that celebrates light, reflection, and nature.

The composition brings serenity into the home, fostering a timeless connection between architecture, landscape, and mindfulness.

Prism

Designed for reading and reflection, the space becomes a retreat where stillness, solitude, and concentration are gently restored.

A linear infinity pool extends towards the horizon, where its vanishing edge transitions seamlessly into a silent reflecting water channel, dissolving the boundary between architecture, water, and sea. Earth-toned materials and a restrained natural palette anchor the design within its desert landscape, creating a timeless dialogue between the built form and its surroundings.

Designed as a place of escape, the resort offers a tranquil environment that encourages guests to slow down, reconnect with nature, and experience the quiet rhythm of the coastline.

Office Entrance

The entrance landscape is designed as a clean, contemporary space that balances elegance with simplicity, creating a strong yet understated first impression. A restrained planting palette enhances the building's architecture while maintaining visual clarity.

Ornamental grasses introduce softness, texture, and seasonal movement, while birch trees add light vertical structure and refined character. Minimal, high-quality paving in neutral tones defines circulation and reinforces the overall design language, resulting in a cohesive and welcoming entrance.

Wadi Residence

Set atop a rocky hillside, 40 minutes outside Muscat, this private villa is carefully integrated into the natural wadi landscape.

The design responds to the site's dramatic rock formations, allowing the architecture and landscape to emerge organically from the terrain rather than compete with it.

Native xeriscape planting, locally inspired earthy materials, and a restrained palette reinforce the connection to the surrounding environment, creating a landscape that is both resilient and timeless.

Conceived as a secluded retreat, the villa offers a peaceful escape where contemporary living is immersed within the raw beauty of Oman rocky mountains.

Infinity Villa

Developed in collaboration with Evaggelos Rizopoulos Architects, the Floating Villa is conceived as a contemporary retreat that explores the relationship between architecture, water, and the horizon. Located in Mykonos, the villa is defined by a minimal organic form with soft, continuous lines that appear to float above an expansive infinity water basin.

The architecture and landscape merge into a seamless composition, creating a sense of weightlessness and infinity. A restrained material palette and clean geometry reflect the simplicity of the Cycladic landscape, while the surrounding water amplifies the connection to sky, sea, and light.

Coastal Villa

The landscape is conceived as a refined extension of the Cycladic setting, centred around a linear pool that frames views towards the Aegean Sea.

Generous poolside terraces and integrated lounging areas offer a calm setting for relaxation, while the simplicity of the landscape reinforces the villa's connection to the coastal environment.

Villa Olea

The landscape design for Villa Olea in Kalamata embraces a contemporary Mediterranean character, rooted in the natural landscape of southern Greece.

A restrained palette of olive trees, ornamental grasses, aromatic planting, native stone, and gravel creates a calm, drought-tolerant garden. Dry-stone walls, warm paving, and sculptural rocks connect the villa to its local landscape, while soft planting contrasts with the clean architectural lines.

The result is a simple, timeless, and natural Mediterranean setting that complements the architecture and surrounding terrain.

Atrium

The landscape design for the atrium in this Villa in Barcelona is conceived as a minimal extension of the architecture, where water, light, and planting create a seamless connection between the villa and its surroundings.

Landscape corridors between the villa blocks are transformed into reflective water mirrors, extending the sky and natural light into the architecture. Subtropical planting is integrated with carefully placed rocks along the house, creating a soft, natural contrast to the clean architectural forms.

The landscape is intentionally restrained, allowing water reflections, natural light, and vegetation to become the main design elements. The result is a calm, immersive setting where the villa appears to float within the landscape.
